In old business:

- ✓ Randy updated the fire board with stats for August and stated they were "on track" with the numbers from last year.
- ✓ The IRS is issuing a refund for overpayment.
- $\checkmark$  The department will be presenting fire safety at the schools.
- $\checkmark$  There will be a Halloween party at the department on October 31<sup>st</sup>.
- $\checkmark$  The November meeting is changed from November 15<sup>th</sup> to November 10<sup>th</sup> due to rifle season.
- $\checkmark$  The ladder truck should be back in service by the next meeting.
