- In Fire Department News:

  - ✓ The department is finally getting direct deposit set up for payroll. There is still a \$30 per month charge, however, others charge much more.
  - ✓ The dry hydrants are still a work in progress.
  - ✓ It was reported that the radios that were previously unreturned by firefighters that had ceased working for the department have all been returned with the exception of one radio. These radios are still in working order, but due to their age cannot be updated.
  - ✓ Shane is busy working on grants and hopes to obtain a drone for search and rescue purposes.
  - ✓ In an effort to provide more consistency in the board representation at the fire board meetings, Sheila Robinson made a motion to appoint Ted Wojcik to the position of fire board representative, Angie Reagan seconded. Motion carried. Terry Pritchard will inform Beverly Mills of this change.
